Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap.136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the release of three plots of land at Mosta.

The three plots of land in question, together with other plots, had been declared to be required for a public purpose by the competent authority by means of a Declaration signed by His Excellency the Governor-General on the 5th November, 1968, and published by Government Notice No. 798 of the 5th November, 1968.

As the said three plots of land are no longer so required by the competent authority, the attached Declaration is intended for their release.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

Whereas by declaration dated the 25th October, 1968, published in the Government Gazette of the 5th November, 1968 under Notice No. 798, His Excellency the Governor-General had declared, amongst other items, the undermentioned land to be required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and whereas the undermentioned land is no longer so required, I hereby declare for all intents and purposes of law, that the undermentioned land is no longer required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the aforementioned Ordinance.

Description of the Land

The following land at Mosta:-

1. A plot of land of the area of 6.93 square canes, bounded on the South and East by the property of the Parish Church of Lija and on the West by the property of Mr. Consigilio D'Amato as regards the perpetual Utile Dominium, and of the Parish Church of Lija as regards the Directum Dominium.
2. A plot of land of the area of 4.64 square canes, bounded on the North, South-East and South-West by the property of the Parish Church of Lija.
3. A plot of land of the area of 93.4 square canes, bounded on the South and East by the property of Mr. Joseph Vella and on the West by the property of the Parish Church of Lija.

The abovementioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 246/71, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
