

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to land within the limits of Kirkop, Gudja, Zurrieq and Birzebbugia.

It is desirable to examine the land described in the aforesaid Declaration with a view to its possible acquisition for a public purpose. This exercise is in accordance with the provision contained in subsection (1) of section 7 of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

In accordance with section 7 (1) of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) I hereby declare that it is desirable that the land described below should be examined with a view to its possible acquisition for a public purpose.

Description of the Land

1. An area situated within the limits of Kirkop known as tad-Dawl, shown coloured blue and marked A, measuring 5.6 Tumoli, bounded on the North by road ta' Hal Reskum and on all other sides by other public roads.
2. An area situated within the limits of Kirkop known as Ta' San Nikola, shown coloured blue and marked B, measuring 39 Tumoli, bounded on the west partly by Government property and partly by private property, on the North, East and South-East by Government property.
3. An area situated within the limits of Gudja and Kirkop known as Tal-kappella tal-Bajda, ta' Harrub Rummien, ta' San Nikola, ta' Cincra, taz-Zebbugija, tat-Tajjar, il-Karwija and ta' Ras il-wied, shown coloured blue and marked C, measuring 576 Tumoli, bounded on the North-East partly by private property and partly by Luqa-Gudja road, on the South-East partly by Government property and partly by Gudja-Hal Far road, on the South-west partly by Government property and partly by Gudja-Hal Far road and on the North-west partly by Government property and partly by private property.
4. An area situated within the limits of Gudja known as tal-madorbu, shown coloured blue and marked D, measuring 66 Tumoli, bounded on the North, North-East and East by Gudja-Hal Far road, on the South-West by private property and on the North-West by Government property.
5. An area situated within the limits of Gudja, Birzebbuga and Zurrieq known as ta' Litorbu, il-Bur tal-Kcina, Knejjes Durbin and ta' Sanserna measuring 485 Tumoli, bounded on the North by Government property, on the North-west by Gudja-Hal Far road and on all other sides by private property.

The abovementioned land is shown on plan marked L.D. 110/72, which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
