

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE
LAND ACQUISITION (PUBLIC PURPOSES) ORDINANCE CAP.136

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to a tenement at St. Julian's.

The proposed acquisition covers part of the "parapett" in front of premises No. 192, Main Street, St. Julian's.

It is intended to acquire by title of absolute purchase.

The part of the "parapett" in question is required by the Government for replanning the footpath at Main Street, St. Julian's. It is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions contained in the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance Cap. 136.

The Land Engineer has valued the freehold value of the land under review at £63.0s.0d.

Honourable Ministers are solicited to recommend.

DECLARATION BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the under-mentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the Land

The following land at St. Julian's:-

Part of the "parapett" in front of premises No. 192, Main Street, St. Julian's of the area of 0.945 square canes, bounded on the West and on the South by Main Street, and on the North-East by the remaining portion of the land of which it forms part, property of Mr Gustav R. Vincenti A. & J.B.

The above-mentioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 145/65 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29 South Street, Valletta.
