

MEMORANDUM BY THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE  
AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS

Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Cap. 136)

The attached Declaration by His Excellency the Governor-General refers to the compulsory acquisition of a plot of land at Saint Julians.

Since this land is permanently required by the Government, it is proposed to acquire it by absolute purchase.

The above plot of land is required by the Government in connection with road widening; it is therefore required for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136).

From the report by the Land Engineer it transpires that the freehold value of the said plot of land amounts to £1,367.10.0d.

Honourable Ministers are invited to recommend.

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DECLARATION BY THE <sup>Acting</sup> GOVERNOR-GENERAL

I hereby declare that the under-mentioned land is required by the competent authority for a public purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Land Acquisition (Public Purposes) Ordinance (Chapter 136) and that the acquisition thereof is to be by absolute purchase.

Description of the land.

The following land at Saint Julian's:-

A plot of land of the area of 114 square canes, bounded on the North and West by St. Andrew's Junction, and on the South by Saint Andrew's Road; it is the property of the Noble Chevalier Alexander Apap Bologna and others.

The abovementioned land is shown on a plan marked L.D. 110/67 which may be seen on demand at the Land Office, 29, South Street, Valletta.
