PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN.
- (e) State whether proceeding; and Names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports), e.g., accompanied by  
*his wife A. and children B. and C. with their Tutor, D. Es., and a Governess, F. G., and Maid Servants, H. K., and Alan  
Servant, L. M. (all British Subjects).*
- The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full.
- In the case of a child, according to the Religion of the child should be stated; and the Religion of the applicant will be  
mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence.
- (f) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.
- (g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration, viz:—  
*Resident British Merchant, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor (as the case may be), giving  
professional or business address.*
- Recommendations from Banking Firms should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
