(e) State whether proceeding, and Names of persons (when accompanied) (unless they be in separate posts), e.g., *I am accompanied by
my wife, Mr. and Mrs. John Smith, and 4 children, and a G. servant, 1 G. man, and Mrs. and Mr. H. K. and Mrs.
Sergeant, L. M. (all British Subjects).*

The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full.

(f) In the case of married children, and of the children of a child, the child should be stated, and the religion of the applicant will be
mentioned in the report on production of a Baptismal Certificate, or other satisfactory evidence.

(g) Where the applicant is unable to write, I wish should be made by him or her in the presence of the person writing the Declaration.

(h) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration, viz.—
Resident British Merchant, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor (in the case any being), giving
residence or business address.

Recommendations from *Parishes* (No. 10) should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
