 (c) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW the particulars of birth required are those of her HUSBAND OR LATE HUSBAND - not of the applicant herself
 (d) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject. In the case of a NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN
 (e) State whether proceeding and names of persons by whom recognized (banks, they hold regular passes) and state if the applicant is a member of the British Legion or other organization.
 In the case of persons proceeding to assist the aged or infirm, the names of the persons to be assisted should be given.
 (f) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.
 (g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz -
 Resident British Merchant, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving professional or business address.
 Recommendations from Bankers, if required, should be in the printed stamp of the Bank.

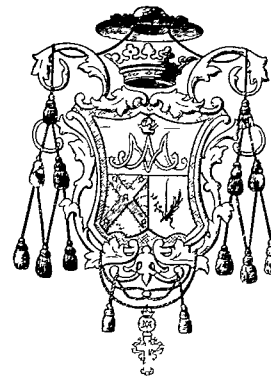
