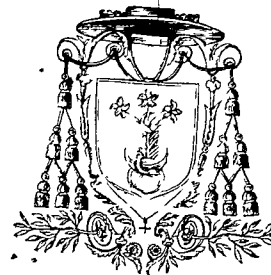

The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full
In the case of persons proceeding to Russia, the ages of children should be stated and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence
(f) Where the applicant is unable to write a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
(g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz --
Resident British Merchant Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister or Solicitor (in the case may be) having professional or business address
Recommendations from Banking Firms should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
