- (g) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN or WIDOW, the particulars of birth registered by her HUSBAND OR FATHER as well as those of the applicant herself.
- (h) State whether a British born Subject or a Naturalized British Subject IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, GIVE DATES OF BIRTH NEEDED FOR PROOF.
- (i) State if already proceeding, and Names of persons by whom accompanied, unless they hold separate passports; e.g., I am applying for my own passport, add first Initials, D. and a Goodman, G., Mr/Mrs/Sir Int H. n. n. M. See also L.M. (all British subject).
- The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full.
In the case of the wife of a British subject, the names of children would be stated, and the relation of the child will be mentioned in the part prior to production of a baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence.
- (j) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mail should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.
- (k) Name and Qualifications of person verifying the Declaration, viz —
A Priest or Minister of Religion, a Judge, a Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister at Law, or Schoolmaster in the case of male applicants, or a Justice of the Peace, or a Magistrate.
- Recommendations from *Baptism-Firms* should bear the printed stamp of the Diocese.
