(4) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject. IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT,
PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN
(5) State whether proceeding, and Names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports) as a passenger by
his wife, children, and others, and if a Government Agent, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Journalist, or Student, as the case may be, giving
the Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full
In the case of persons proceeding to Russia the names of children should be stated, and the religion of the applicant it will be
mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence
(6) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
(7) A statement of persons verifying the Declaration, viz—
A British Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Journalist, or Student, as the case may be, giving
profession and true name and address
Recommendations from British Foreign should bear the printed stamp of the British
