(5) State whether proceeding, and names of persons by whom accepted (unless they have signed a statement to the contrary, to be signed by the Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full. In the case of persons proceeding to receive the official children should be stated and the children of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a birth certificate or other satisfactory evidence.
