- (c) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW, the particulars of birth required are those of her HUSBAND OR LATE HUSBAND - not of the applicant herself
- (d) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject. IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH AND DATE NOT REQUIRED
- (e) State whether proceeding and names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports), the wife of an alien and children and children (to be struck out in the case of a British subject). In the case of persons proceeding to visit the ages of children should be stated and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence
- (f) Where the applicant is unable to write, it must be read by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
- (g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration, Assistent British Consul General, Minister of Education, Hydrabad, Secunderabad, or elsewhere (as the case may be), living privately or business address
