- (1) Insert true of Place and Date
- (2) Christian Names and Surname of the applicant in full, and present address
- (3) In the case of a MARRIED MAN or WIDOW, the particulars of birth required are those of her HUSBAND or LATE HUSBAND - not of the applicant herself
- (4) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalised British Subject IN THE CASE OF A NATURALISED BRITISH SUBJECT, particulars of birth of the subject must be given
- (5) State whether married or single Name of any persons whom accompanied (and, if the said separate persons are a wife or husband, last wife or last husband and children of the father or mother, of the said husband or wife, as the case may be, and, if the British subject)
- The Christian Names and Surname of each person must be given in full
- In the case of persons proceeding to RESIDE in the colony of children should be stated and the education of the applicant will be mentioned in the particulars on production of a valid Ismail Certificate or other satisfactory evidence
- (6) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
- (7) Name and Qualification of the person verifying the Declaration, viz -
A *Colonial Medical Officer*, or a *Minister of Religion*, or a *Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor* (as the case may be), giving profession and of residence address
- Recommendations from *Banks, Firms* should be the printed stamp of the Bank
