(5) State whether proceeding and names of persons to whom a composite taken, they to be given in full  
In the case of persons proceeding to Russia the names of children should be stated and the father and mother will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence  
(6) The applicant is unable to write a mark shall be made by him or her in the presence of the official verifying the Declaration  
(7) A notary public or other person verifying the Declaration, viz—  
Resident British Merchant, Minister of Religion, Surgeon, Barrister, or other person as the case may be shall sign the passport and the passport shall bear the printed stamp of the Local

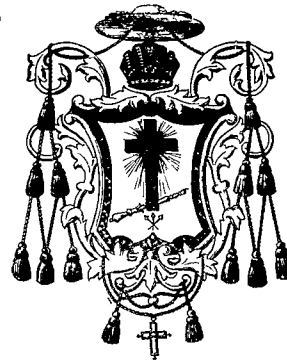
