- [Q] Where the sign is unable to write, a mail should be used by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.
- (6) Name and Qualification of person verifying same, in Declaration may be—
A solemn British slave int Linker Minister of Justice, n Physician, Surgeon, Bar atw as Sheriff, (as the case may be), living
in possession of his senses &c.
