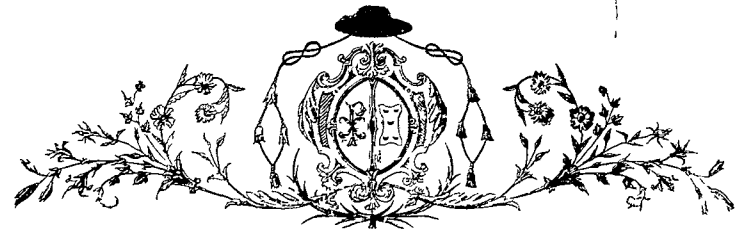

(g) In the case of persons proceeding to RESIDE in the Colonies, children should be registered, and the registration of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence.
(h) If the applicant is unable to write, a mark, and the mark by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.
(i) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz. —
A Clergyman, Minister of the Gospel, Justice of the Peace, Magistrate, or other person (as the case may be), having professional or business address.
