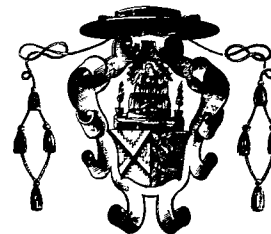

 (3) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW the particulars of birth required are those of her HUSBAND (to be struck out of the applicant herself)
 (4) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject. IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN.
 (5) State whether proceeding, and Names of persons (to whom was married (unless they hold a passport) or of persons to whom was married (if all the children are to be taken) and the Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full. The Christian Name and Surname of children should be stated, and the religion of the applicant will be stated in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence.
 (6) If the applicant is unable to write a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.
 (7) A qualified person verifying the Declaration, as required by the Act, must be a Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, or a person of similar standing, giving professional business address.
 (8) Recommendations from British Firms should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
