(c) Christian Name and Surname of the applicant in full, and present address.
(d) In the case of a MALED WIDOW or WIDOW, the particulars of birth required are those of her Husband or late Husband - not of the applicant herself.
(e) State whether a British-born Subject or a naturalized British Subject. IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH ARE NOT REQUIRED.
(f) State whether present, and Name of persons by whom recommended (unless they hold SPECIAL PASSPORTS, &c., accompanied by his wife, &c., and Children &c., and a Certificate, P. G., and Child Service, &c., and a Certificate, &c., for each child).
The Certificate must be signed by each person next to be given in full.
In the case of persons proceeding to Egypt, the age of children should be stated; and the father of the applicant will be required to be present at the presentation of a Special Certificate or other satisfactory evidence.
(g) Must be applicant in writing, a name should be made to him or her in the presence of the person signing the certificate.
(h) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration, &c.
Resident British Magistrate, Justice, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor (in the case of any other person, a recommendation from a Justice of the Peace should be sent, the printed stamp of the Bench).
