- (b) Christian Name and Surname of the applicant is full, and given address.
- (c) In the case of a MAISON VIVANT or WIDOW, the particulars of birth required are those of her HUSBAND or LATE HUSBAND—last of the applicant's birth.
- (d) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject. In the case of a NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF HIS PREVIOUS STATUS.
- (e) State whether proceeding, and names of persons by whom passport is taken, they hold separate passports, i.e., accompanied by his wife, or with children, &c., and state their ages, &c., and a Government, P. O., and Street Address, &c., and their Service, &c. All 1891 British Subjects.
- (f) In the case of persons proceeding to the Colonies, the ages of children should be stated, and the religion of the applicant will be presumed to be the religion of his parents, unless he is a different Christian or other religious denomination.
- (g) Where the applicant is unable to write, a declaration may be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.
- (h) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration, viz., British Consul, Honorary Consul, Governor, Mayor of Borough, Magistrate, Clergyman, Minister, or Solicitor, at the time and place, giving full name and address of person verifying the Declaration.
