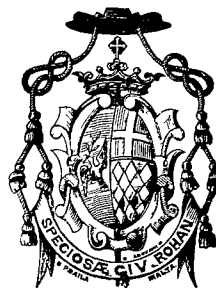

- (1) Insert name of Place and Date
- (2) Christian Names and Surname of the applicant in full, and present address
- (3) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN or WIDOW, the particulars of birth required in the case of her HUSBAND - not of the applicant herself
- (4) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject. In the case of a NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN
- (5) State whether proceeding, and Names of persons in whom a companion (unless they hold separate passports, e.g. a companion in his wife and children b and c, with two Tutor, D E and Governor, F G, and Master Servant, H K and Min Servant, L M (all British Subjects))
- The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full
- In the case of persons proceeding to foreign parts, the ages of children should be stated and the reason of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence
- (6) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
- (7) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz -
A Notary Public, a Minister of Religion, a Magistrate, a Surgeon, a Priest, or a Justice of the Peace (as the case may be) and his professional or business address
- Recommendations from Banking Firms should bear the printed stamp of the Bank
