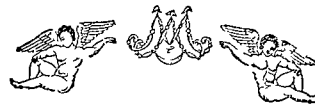

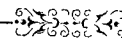

(2) Christian Names and Surname of the applicant in full, and present address.
(3) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN or WIDOW, the particulars of birth required are those of her HUSBAND or FATHER (to be struck out in other cases).
(4) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject. IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN.
(5) State whether proceeding, and names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold valid passports) e.g., as a friend to his wife, I am accompanied by and with Mr. J. D. F., and I have seen I. G. and Mr. D. H. K. and Mr. S. A. M. (all British Subjects).
The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full.
In the case of persons proceeding to RESIDE, the names of children should be stated, and the reason of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Dispensation Certificate or other satisfactory evidence.
(6) When the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.
(7) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration, viz —
A. Clerk, British Merchant, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Lawyer, or S. A. M. (as the case may be), giving Recommendations from Banking, Firms should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
