- (2) Christian Name and Surname of the applicant in full, and present address
- (3) In the case of a MARRIED MAN or WIDOW, the particulars of birth required are those of last MARRIAGE or 1st MARRIAGE of the applicant himself
- (4) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH MUST NOT BE GIVEN
- (5) State whether proceeding in the Name of (persons) who accompanied (rank) to his last voyage (ship), or a companion (or wife or a child or a brother or sister or a friend or a friend's servant, &c.) (all British subjects)
- The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full in the case of the wife, of the child or of the brother or sister of the applicant should be stated, and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the first part on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence
- (6) Where the applicant is unable to write a vessel should be named by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
- (7) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz —
A Captain, a Master, a Surgeon, a Minister of Religion, a Physician, a Surgeon, a Minister, or a Scholar (as the case may be), giving, professional or business address
- Recommendations from a Minister of Religion should also be written signed of the Bank
