(d) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN
(e) State whether proceeding and Names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passport) *never signed by his wife and child in P. and C. with their full D.F. and 1 Go on 1 G. and 1 M. S. 111 11 K. 111 11 M. S. 111 11 V. (all British Subjects)*
The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full
In the case of persons proceeding to Russia the ages of children shall be stated and the children of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence
(f) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
(g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz *Resident British Merchant, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving professional or business address*
Recommendations from Banking Firms should bear the printed stamp of the Bank
