- (b) Christian Names and Surname of the applicant in full, and present address.
- (c) In the case of a **MARRIED WOMAN** OR **WIDOW**, the particulars of birth required are those of her **HUSBAND** OR **LATE HUSBAND**—not of the applicant herself
- (d) State whether a **British-born Subject** or a **naturalized British Subject**. **IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN.**
- (e) Set out briefly preceding; and Names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports), *e.g., accompanied by his wife A. and children B. and C., with their Tutor, D. E., and a Governor, F. G., and Miss Servant, H. M. (all British Subjects)*.
The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full.
- (f) In the case of persons who are not British Subjects, the religion should be stated; and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a **Baptismal Certificate** or other satisfactory evidence.
- (g) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.
- (h) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration, viz.—
Resident British Merchant, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor (as the case may be), giving professional or business address.
- Recommendations from **Banking Firms** should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
