DECLARATION TO BE MADE BY APPLICANT FOR PASSPORT.

and not having lost the status of British Subject thus acquired, and I hereby apply for a Passport for the purpose of travelling to (e) Alexandria of Egypt

residing at St. Dominic's Parish hereby declare that to the best of my knowledge and belief the above made Declaration of the said Andrew Domicoli is true, and that he is a fit and proper person to receive a Passport

- (a) Invert name of Place and Date
(b) Christian Names and Surname of the applicant in full and present address.
(c) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW the particulars of birth required are those of her HUSBAND OR LATE HUSBAND—not of the applicant herself
(d) Note whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject. IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN
(e) In their proceedings, and names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports) e.g. accompanied by Mr. L. M. (all British Subjects)
The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full
In the case of persons proceeding to Russia the ages of children should be stated and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence.
(f) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
(g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration, viz —
Parish Priest (British Merchant, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister or Solicitor (in the case only), being recommended by Banking Firm) should bear the printed stamp of the Bank
