- (g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz—
 Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving professional or business address.
 Recommendations from Banking Firms should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
