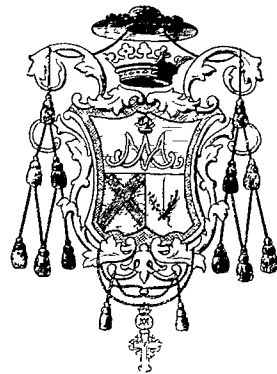

- (a) Insert name of Applicant and Date
(b) Christian Names and Surname of the applicant in full and present address
(c) In the case of a Married Woman or Widow the particulars of birth required are those of her husband and not of the applicant herself
(d) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject. In the case of a naturalized British Subject, particulars of birth need not be given
(e) State whether present and names of persons who have been in possession of a passport in the last year and date of issue of the same
(f) Christian Names and Surname of each person must be given in full and the names of persons proceeding to the same place as children of the applicant will be included in the passport on production of a certificate or other satisfactory evidence
(g) A certificate is not to be issued to a minor child unless he or she is in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
(h) A certificate is not to be issued in the case of a minor child unless the parent or guardian is present and signs the Declaration and the certificate is countersigned by the official of the Malta Consulate
(i) The certificate is not to be issued unless the applicant is a British subject or a naturalized British subject and is of legal age and is not a minor child
