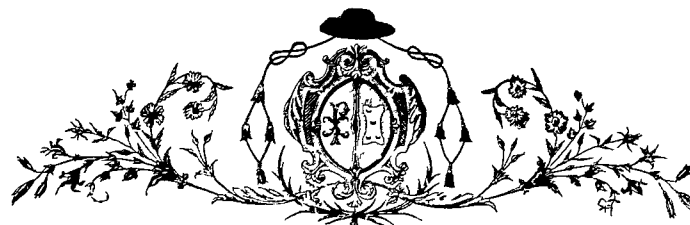

(g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz —
Notary British Merchant, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving profession and or true name and address
Recommendations from Banking Firms should bear the printed stamp of the Bank
