(f) Christian Names and Surname of the applicant in full, and present address.
(g) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW, the particulars of birth required are those of her HUSBAND OR LATE HUSBAND—not of the applicant herself.
(h) If the applicant is a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN.
(i) State either proceeding and Names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports) e.g., accompanied by his father and children B and C, with their Tutor, D, F and a Governor G, and Maid Servant, H, K and Alan L. Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full.
In the case of persons proceeding to RUSSIA the ages of children should be stated and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence.
(j) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.
(k) Name of the person verifying the Declaration, viz—
Trade Agent, Merchant, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving residence and full business address.
Recommendations from Banking Firms should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
