(e) State whether proceeding and Names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports) e.g. accompanied by Mr & Mrs A and children B and C with their Tutor D E and Miss F G and Miss H I K and Miss L M (all British Subjects)
The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full
In the case of persons proceeding to Russia the ages of children should be stated and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Passport Certificate or other satisfactory evidence.
(f) Where the applicant is unable to write a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
(g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration, viz —
Notary, Merchant, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving full name and address
Recent embassies from Banking Firms should bear the printed stamp of the Bank
