 (g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz —
1st de 1 British Merchant, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor (as the case may be), giving
profession and full address
 Recommendations from Banking Firms should bear the printed stamp of the Bank
