- (f) Christian Names and Surname of the applicant in full and present address.
- (g) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW the particulars of birth require I are those of her HUSBAND OR LATE HUSBAND—not of the applicant herself
- State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN
- State whether proceeding and Names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports) e.g. accompanied by his wife A and children B and C with their Tutor D E and a Governess F G and Maid Servant H K and also Servant L M (all British Subjects)
- The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full
- In the case of persons proceeding to RUSSIA the ages of children should be stated and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence
- (h) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
- (i) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz —
Resident British Merchant Banker, Minister of Education, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving professional or business address
- Recommendations from a Bank Firm should bear the printed stamp of the Bank
