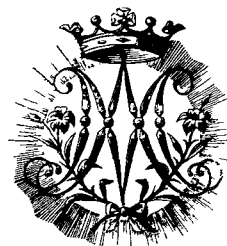

Resident British Merchant Banker Minister of Religion, Physician Surgeon Barrister or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving address and full business title
 Recommendations from a Banking Firm should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
