- In the case of children of a British Subject, the names of children must be given in full and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on products of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence
- (f) Where the applicant is unable to write a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
- (g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz —
Resident District Magistrate British Minister Judge, or Physician Surgeon Barrister or Solicitor (in the case may be giving Professional or other title)
- Recommendations for a *Bar* King should be the printed stamp of the Bank
