residing at Stade Rich. hereby declare that to the best of my knowledge and belief the above made Declaration of the said Spirdione Louis is true and that he is a fit and proper person to receive a Passport

(c) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW the particulars of birth require that those of her HUSBAND OR LATR HUSBAND not of the applicant herself.
(d) In the case of a NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT the particulars of birth need not be given.
(e) In the case of a BRITISH BORN SUBJECT or a NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT the particulars of birth need not be given.
(f) Where the applicant is unable to write a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.
(g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz - Resident British Notary Public Minister of Religion Physician Surgeon, Barrister or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving professional or business address.
Recommendations from a British Firm should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
