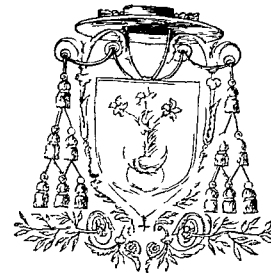

(e) In the case of persons proceeding to Russia the names of children should be stated and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence

(f) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration

(g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz: —
Resident British Merchant Banker Minister of Religion Physician Surgeon Barrister or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving professional or business address
