Resident British Merchant Banker Minister of Religion Physician Surgeon Barrister or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving
professional or business address
Recommendations from Bank Firms should bear the printed stamp of the Bank

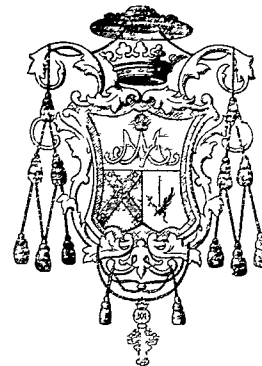
