(d) See whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject. IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN.  
(e) In the case of persons proceeding to RUSSIA the names of children should be given and the religious of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence.  
(f) Where the applicant is unable to write a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.  
(g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz—  
Resident British Merchant Banker Master of a Ship Physician Surgeon Barrister or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving professional or business address.  
Recommendations from Banks and Firms should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
