- The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full
- In the case of persons proceeding to ALIEN status, the names of children should be stated, and the names of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence
- (f) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
- (g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz --
Reside in British Empire, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister or Solicitor (as the case may be), giving professional or business address
- Recommendations for a *British Firm* should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
