- State whether a British born Subject or a naturalised British Subject IN THE CASE OF A NATURALISED BRITISH SUBJECT PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN
- State whether accompanied, and Names of persons with whom accompany (unless they hold separate, pass ports) *e.g.* accompanied by *his wife A. and children B. and C. with their Tutor D. E. and a Governess F. G. and Maid Servant H. A. and Men Servant L. M. (all British Subjects)*
- The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full
- In the case of persons proceeding to the Colonies, the children should be stated, and the reason of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence
- (f) Where the applicant is unable to write a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of a person verified by the Declaration
- (g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz — *Resident By law Mr John Barker Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving professional or business address*
- Recommendations for a *Business Firm* should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
