(f) Where the applicant is unable to write a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration

(g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz. -  
Resident British Magistrate, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving professional or business address
