residing at Udo, Enugu hereby declare that I am

FOR A MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW (to be struck out in other cases) Particulars of Husband's birth to follow

(c) I the wife of Bartholomew and that my husband is Bartholomew having been born at Enugu on the 13 day of Jan 1902

FOR PERSONS BORN ABROAD who derive British nationality from a father or paternal grandfather born within His Majesty's Dominions (To be struck out in other cases)

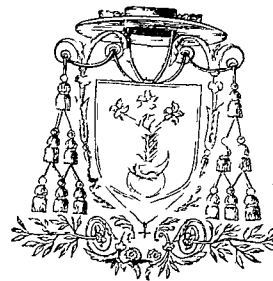
my (his) father having been born within His Majesty's Dominions at Enugu on the 13 day of Jan 1902

(b) Christian Names and Surname of the applicant in full and present address
(c) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW the particulars of birth require to be those of her HUSBAND OR LATE HUSBAND not of the applicant herself
(d) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalised British Subject. IN THE CASE OF A NATURALISED BRITISH SUBJECT PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN
(e) State whither proceeding and Names of persons by whom accompanied (unless it is held separate passports) e.g. accompanied by his wife A and children B and C with their Tutor D F and a Governess G and Maid Servant H K and Ma Servant L M (all British Subjects)
The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full
In the case of persons proceeding to RUSSIA the ages of children should be stated and the religion (if the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence)
(f) Where the applicant is unable to write a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration
(g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz —
Resident British Master of the Ship, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving professional or business address
Recommendations from a Banking Firm should bear the printed stamp of the Bank
