- (c) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW, the particulars of birth required are those of her HUSBAND OR LATE HUSBAND — out of the applicant herself.
- (d) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject. IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN.
- (e) It is further prescribed, and Names of persons by whom recommended (unless they hold separate permits) to be — *I am employed by Mr. W. J. & Co. as Chief Clerk & I, Mr. D. L. and C. & Co. as J. L. G. and Miss Servant. If K. and A. J. Servant, L. M. (all British Subjects).*
- The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full.
- (f) In the case of the issue of a passport to a British subject, the ages of children, as should be stated, and the names of the applicant will be mentioned in the pass-port on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other proper evidence.
- (g) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.
- (h) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration to be — *Resident British M. J. and Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister or Solicitor (as the case may be), giving professional or business address.*
- (i) Recommendations for a *Blue Form* should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
