- (g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz —
Resident Director in Charge Minister of Religion Physician Surgeon Barrister or Solicitor (as the case may be) giving professional or business address.

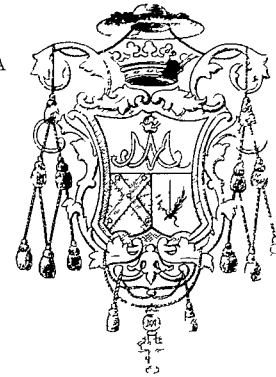
