(j) State whether a Distressed Refugee or a non-national British Subject. IN THE CASE OF A MARRIED BRITISH SUBJECT,
say whether his wife is also a British Subject.

(k) Name, address and names of persons by whom compensated parties they hold joint or proprietary, e.g., agents, factors, &c., and their business, &c., with their trades, D. L., and C. G., and their servants, H. M., and their business, &c., and their trades.

The Classes of Head and Servants of each person must be given in full.
The name of the applicant is given in full so as it should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the declaration.

(l) Name and address of person applying for Passport, Assistant Police Commissioner, Bowditch, Secretary, Notary Public, Barrister, or Solicitor (in the case of a lessee, giving premises or business address).

Any remittance from the said Person should bear the printed name of the Bank.
