 (d) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN  
 (e) State whether proceeding in the names of persons by whom represented (unless they hold separate passports) or on behalf of the wife of a naturalized British Subject, and if Government, Local or Marine in Her Majesty's Service, L. M. (all British Subjects)  
 The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full  
 In the case of persons proceeding to the Colonies, the ages of children should be stated, and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence.  
 (f) Where the applicant is unable to write, the name should be made known or put in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration  
 (g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration is  
 Lieutenant British Merchant Banker, Member of the Council of the Bank of India, and Barrister at Law (in the case of the Bank), giving the address  
 Accept no conditions from Banking Ferris should bear the printed stamp of the Bank
