

DECLARATION TO BE MADE BY APPLICANT FOR PASSPORT.

(c) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW the particulars of birth required are those of her HUSBAND OR LATE HUSBAND—not of the applicant herself
(d) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject. IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT, PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN
(e) State whether proceeding and names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports) as wife and of their Tutor, D. L., and a Governor, P. G. and Valid Sergeant, H. K. and Van
The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full
In the case of persons proceeding to Russia the ages of children should be stated and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate, or other satisfactory evidence
(f) Where the applicant is unable to write he should be made to sign in the presence of the person verifying the declaration
(g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration Resident British Consul Banker Master of the Ship Physician Surgeon Barrister, or Solicitor (in the case may be) giving professional address
Recommendations from Banking Firms should bear the printed stamp of the Firm
