- (f) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the persons verifying the Declaration.
- (g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration, viz. —  
Resident British Merchant, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor (as the case may be), giving professional or business address.
