(b) Christian Names and Surnames of the applicant in full and present address
(c) In the case of a MARRIED WOMAN OR WIDOW the particulars of birth required are those of her HUSBAND OR LATE HUSBAND—not of the applicant herself
(d) State whether a British born Subject or a naturalized British Subject IN THE CASE OF A NATURALIZED BRITISH SUBJECT PARTICULARS OF BIRTH NEED NOT BE GIVEN
(e) State whether proceeding and Names of persons by whom accompanied (unless they hold separate passports) e.g. accompanied by his wife A and children B and C with their Tutor D E and a Governor F G and a Valet Servant H I and a Nurse J K (all British Subjects)
The Christian Name and Surname of each person must be given in full
In the case of persons proceeding to Russia the ages of children should be stated and the religion of the applicant will be mentioned in the passport on production of a Baptismal Certificate or other satisfactory evidence
(f) Where the applicant is unable to write, a signature should be made by him or herself in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.
(g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration viz—
Assistant British Consul, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister or Solicitor (as the case may be), giving prominent or prominent address
Recommendations from Foreign Princes should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
