- (f) Where the applicant is unable to write, a mark should be made by him or her in the presence of the person verifying the Declaration.
- (g) Name and Qualification of person verifying the Declaration, viz.:-  
*Resident British Merchant, Banker, Minister of Religion, Physician, Surgeon, Barrister, or Solicitor* (as the case may be), giving address and business address.
- Recommendations from *Banking Firms* should bear the printed stamp of the Bank.
